

Spencer assumes Chairmanship of the Liverpool Branch of the ICS

At the Branch AGM on the 2 December 2014 Spencer Barton-Hope, Shipping Manager, Bibby Line Limited (BLL), assumed Chairmanship of the Liverpool Branch of the Institute of Chartered Shipbrokers (ICS). The Liverpool Branch is the second oldest branch of the institute after London and it has been in formal existence since 1917 although the Shipbroker Benevolent Society has existed in Liverpool for over 121 years.
